Summary

A 4 week servant and discipleship focused program for 17 & 18 year olds who will learn what it takes to be a staff member at Cho-Yeh. To uphold the mission of Cho-Yeh in word and action.

Essential Job Functions:

- Behind the scene jobs that help camp run smoothly.
- Dining Hall responsibilities
 - Set tables for every meal, including all dishware and food that starts on tables.
 - Roam the dining hall during meals making sure cabins that need more food can find it.
 - Dish room: wash and put away all dishes after every meal.
 - Sweep floors after every meal, mop after dinner.
- Program responsibilities: assist with A/O games, H2ChoMania and evening programs as needed. Prepared to dress up in costume and act as different characters as needed.
- Special Breakfast: decorate, serve and generally make Special Breakfast awesome.
- Crud Wars: take care of the Crud Wars course and program for all campers.
- Opening/Closing Day responsibilities:
 - Luggage Lumping
 - Lice check
 - Check-out campers
- Trash run of camp every day.
- Participate in group Bible study, and training sessions throughout the term.
- Shadow assigned cabins, learning from counselors in that cabin.
- During fourth week, become a junior counselor in a cabin of elementary or junior high campers.
- Perform other duties as assigned or reassigned.

Qualifications:

- Must be 17 or 18 years of age at the time of employment.
- Must be able to supervise children on a twenty-four hour, seven days a week basis with limited time off.
- Must be able to negotiate hilly terrain, rustic trails, and walk several miles per day.
- Must possess the stamina to carry out camp programs in hot and humid East Texas climate over an extended period of time.
- Must possess visual and auditory abilities to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to camp activity.
- Must demonstrate strong moral and Christian values and set an example of living the Gospel of Jesus Christ on a daily basis.
- Must be willing to oversee Bible Study consistent with Cho-Yeh's Bible Study curriculum.
- Must possess the ability to communicate and work with groups of all ages and skill levels in order to provide necessary instruction to campers.
- Must be able to observe camper behavior, evaluate its appropriateness, and enforce and implement appropriate behavior management techniques.
- Must maintain a positive attitude and provide a positive environment for campers and counselors.
