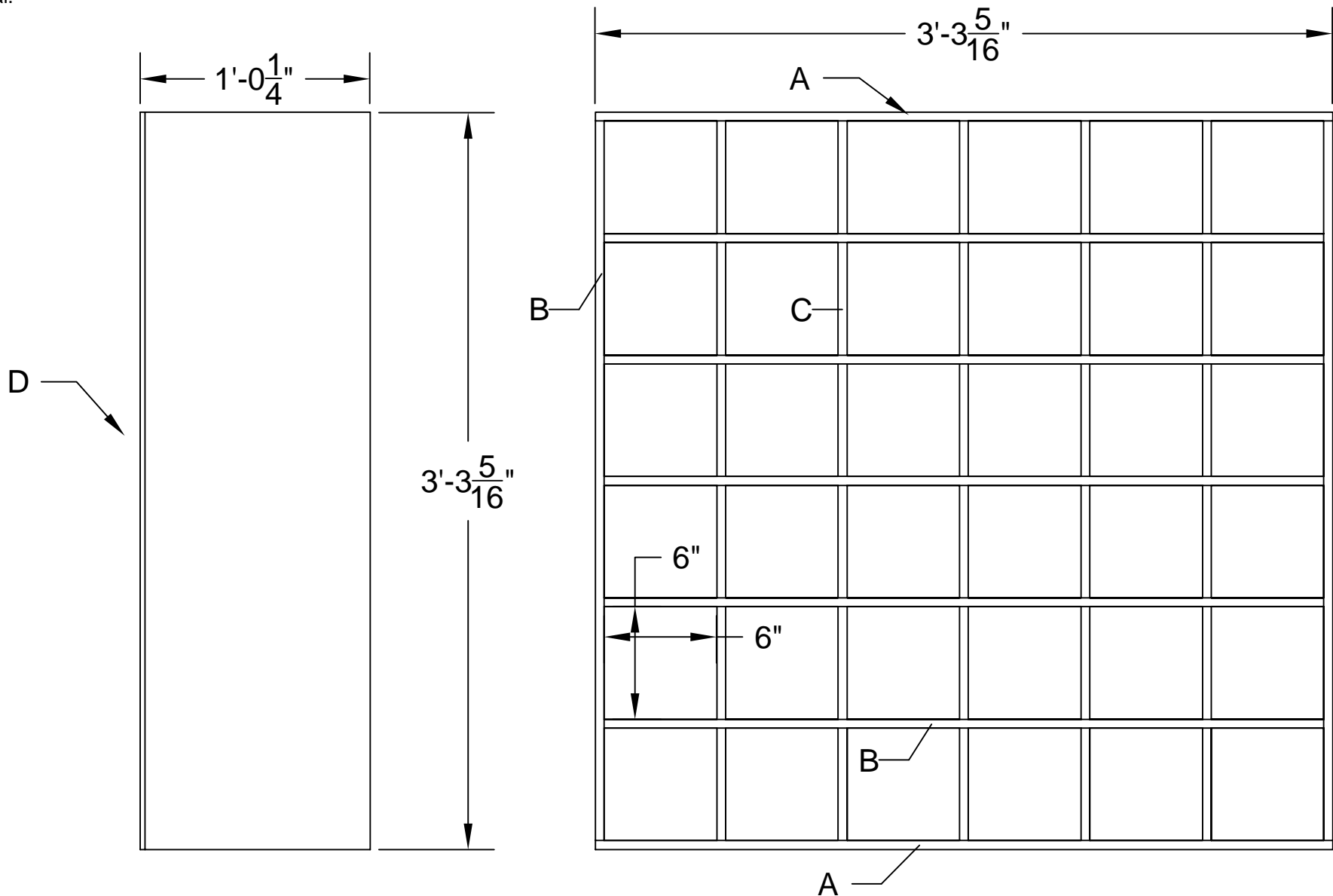
Two sets of cubbies can be made from (3) sheets of $\frac{1}{2}$ " Sanded Plywood and (1) Sheet of $\frac{1}{4}$ " Lauan or birch plywood.

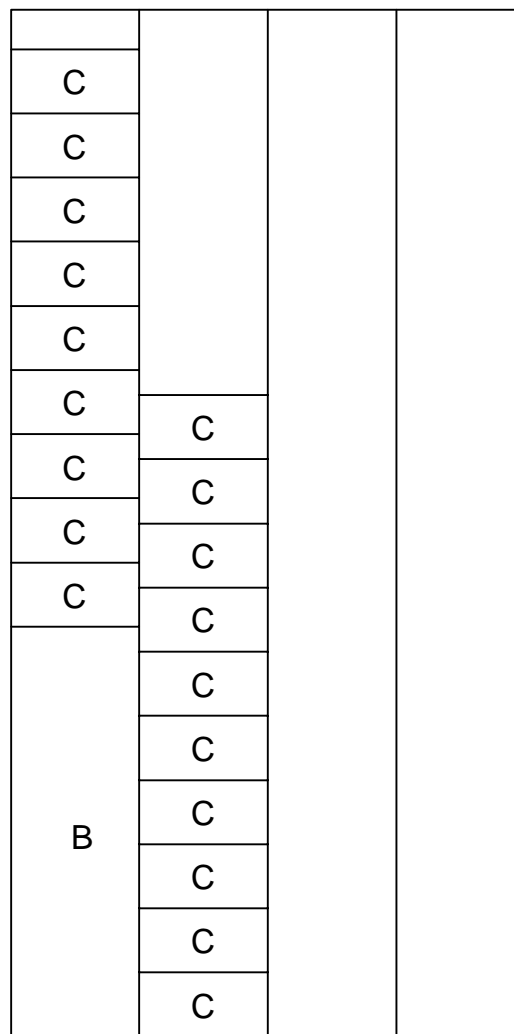
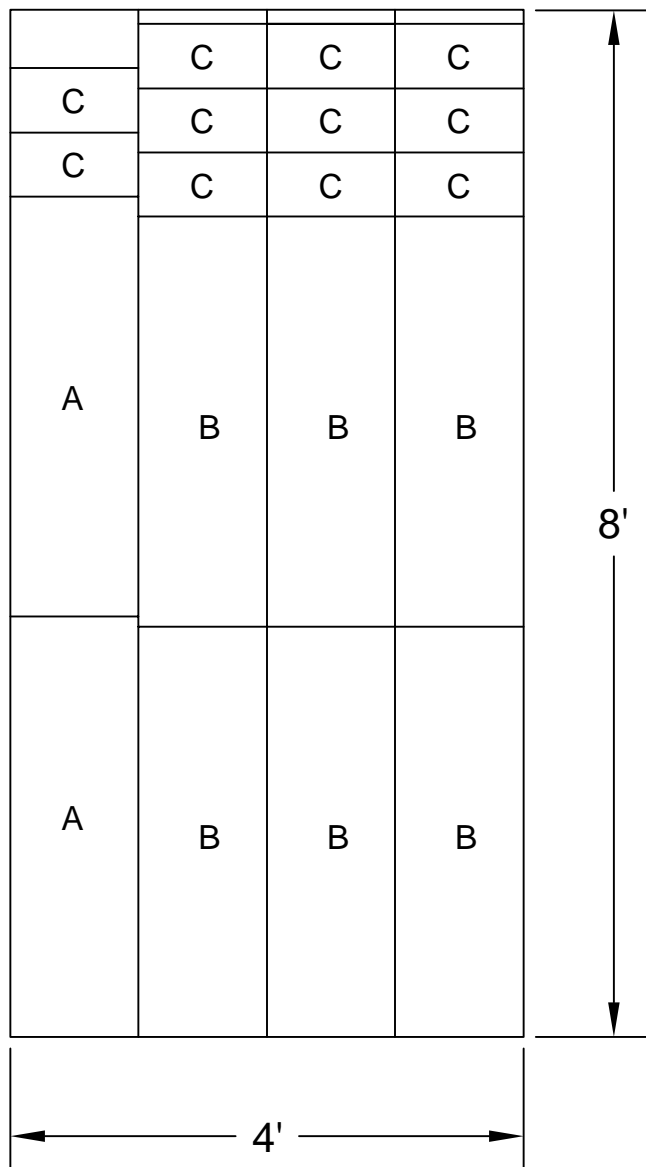
Please coat with two coats of polyurethane or spar varnish. They will be on covered porches but still exposed to the elements.

See cut schedule on next page. Cut schedule is for one cubbie and does not show the $\frac{1}{4}$ " plywood back.

Can be built w/ 2", 16 gauge finish nails or trim screws

While not on the drawings, please rip some strips of material to cover the plywood edge, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ " by $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Attach with trim nails and poly with rest of material.





PARTS FOR CUBBIES

FOR 2 CUBBIES YOU NEED
THREE SHEETS OF $\frac{1}{2}$ "
SANDED PLYWOOD AND
ONE SHEET OF $\frac{1}{4}$ " PLYWOOD

WIDTH OF ALL PARTS
SHOWN AT RIGHT IS 12"
MINUS THE WIDTH OF THE
BLADE TO EQUALLY DIVIDE
THE PLYWOOD SHEET

NUMBERS BELOW IS FOR
ONE CUBBIE

ITEM NUMBER	LENGTH
A	2 39-5/16"
B	7 38-3/8"
C	30 6"

ITEM D IS 39-5/16" SQUARE
AND SHOULD BE WELL
NAILED OR SCREWED TO
THE BACK OF THE CUBBIES
TO KEEP THE STRUCTURE
SQUARE
